CAREGIVERS OF SOUTHERN CARROLL COUNTY

CENTRAL NEW HAMPSHIRE VNA AND HOSPICE

Promotes dignity, independence and well-being through the delivery of quality home health, hospice care and community based services.

CHILD ADVOCACY CENTER OF CARROLL COUNTY

Provides justice and healing to children who are either suspected or confirmed victims of child abuse.

END 68 HOURS OF HUNGER

This program puts food in the hands of local school children who receive insufficient food at home to carry them through the weekend.

FUEL ASSISTANCE THROUGH FCCW GOOD SAMARITAN FUND

A student formed and led organization that provides weekend meals to middle and senior high school students needing food assistance.

LIFE MINISTRIES FOOD PANTRY

Provides food to families in need.

NORTHERN HUMAN SERVICES

Offers mental health services for individuals, couples, families and groups in Carroll County.

WOLFEBORO AREA CHILDREN'S CENTER

Provides comprehensive, affordable, high quality childcare and family services for children 6 weeks to 12 years of age.

WOLFEBORO AREA MEALS ON WHEELS

Provides weekday noontime meals to homebound elderly and disabled residents of Wolfeboro, Tuftonboro, and Brookfield for a minimal fee.

WOLFEBORO NURSERY SCHOOL

Cooperative preschool offering affordable educational offerings for children 3 to 6 years old.
